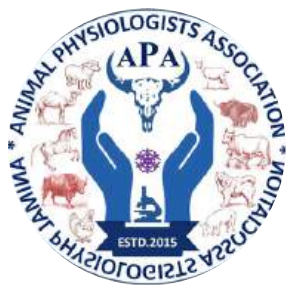

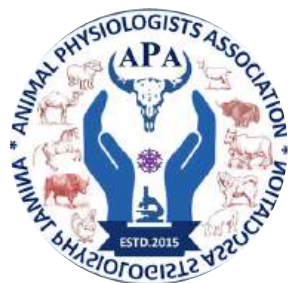

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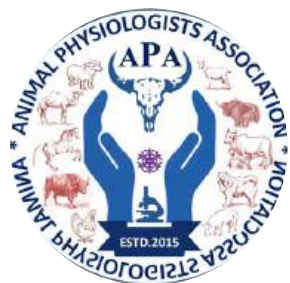
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ABOUT CONFERENCE

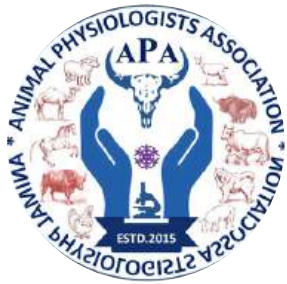

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ABOUT UNIVERSITY

Banaras Hindu University is an internationally reputed temple of learning (सर्व विद्या की राजधानी), situated in the holy city of Varanasi. Founded in **1916** by Bharat Ratna Mahamana Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya ji with the support of Dr Annie Besant, BHU was established through the B.H.U. Act 1915 and envisioned as the “University of India.” Today, it stands among Asia’s most prestigious centers of learning, blending Indian traditions with modern scientific knowledge. Sprawling over 1,300 acres, BHU hosts a vibrant academic community, cutting-edge research facilities, and a legacy of excellence in education. With students and faculty from across India and abroad, it fosters innovation, cultural exchange, and holistic development. The university comprises **6 institutes, 14 faculties, 144 departments, 4 interdisciplinary centers, a constituent college for women, and 3 constituent schools**, spanning humanities, social sciences, technology, medicine, science, fine arts, performing arts, and many more. It has 6 centers of advanced studies, 10 departments under the special assistance program, and numerous specialized research centers. Four degree colleges in the city are affiliated with BHU. The university has a **campus at Varanasi and the Rajiv Gandhi South Campus (RGSC) at Barkachha, Mirzapur**. RGSC [land area - 2700 acres] is being developed as a hub of education, training, and entrepreneurship for youth and women, particularly from rural, tribal, and weaker sections. Its serene campus, rich heritage, and dynamic intellectual environment make BHU an ideal venue for global academic gatherings.

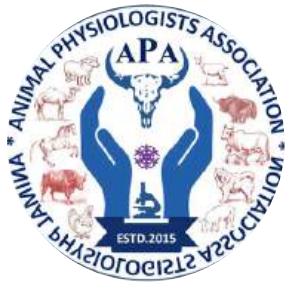


ABOUT INSTITUTE, FACULTY & DEPARTMENT

Recognizing the importance of agriculture in India’s economy, Bharat Ratna Pt. Madan Mohan Malaviya established the Institute of Agricultural Research in 1931, now it's known as the **Institute of Agricultural Sciences**, completing 95 years. Within this institute, the **Faculty of Veterinary & Animal Sciences (FVAS)** was created in **2015** with presidential approval, comprising **15 departments and 2 units (LFC & TVCC) at the RGSC, B.H.U., Barkachha, Mirzapur**.

Spread over 126 acres, FVAS offers world-class teaching and research facilities, nurturing elite veterinary professionals under BHU’s legacy. 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ABOUT VARANASI & MIRZAPUR

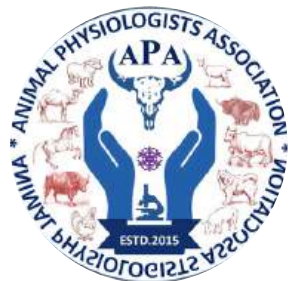
Varanasi, also known as **Kashi (काशी) or Banaras (बनारस)**, is one of the oldest living cities in the world and a timeless symbol of India's spiritual essence. Situated on the banks of the sacred Ganges, it is renowned for the Ganga Aarti at Dashashwamedh Ghat, the revered Kashi Vishwanath Temple, and its rich traditions of classical music and silk weaving. Banaras Hindu University, one of Asia's largest and most prestigious institutions, further enriches the city's cultural and academic landscape, with the Bharat Kala Bhavan museum showcasing India's artistic heritage. Varanasi embodies the spiritual and cultural heartbeat of India.

Mirzapur, located in southeastern Uttar Pradesh, is renowned for its natural beauty and cultural heritage. Nestled along the Ganges, it is famous for the *Maa Vindhyavasini temple (one of the sakti peeths)*, waterfalls like Tanda and Sirsi, and scenic hills that attract pilgrims and tourists alike. The district is also known for its **carpet weaving industry**, which has earned global recognition. With its blend of spirituality, craftsmanship, and landscapes, Mirzapur offers a serene backdrop that complements Varanasi's vibrant cultural heartbeat.

Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport (VNS), Babatpur, 84 km/1.5 hrs away

TRANSPORT :

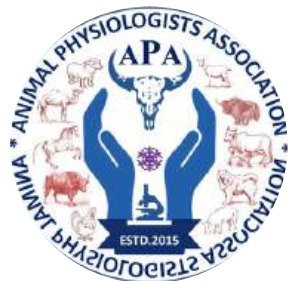


Local transportation between the accommodation and the conference venue will be facilitated by the organizers during the event.

Therefore, participants are advised to carry light woolen clothing for the nights along with regular cotton wear for the day.



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CALL FOR REGISTRATION & ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Delegates are invited to submit abstracts with a maximum word limit of **250 words**, prepared in **MS Word** format using **Times New Roman** font. For APACON 2026, abstracts should be typed in **11-point size** with **1.5 line spacing**. Each abstract must include the **title, author(s)' name(s)** (surname followed by initials), and their **affiliations with full addresses**. The name of the **presenting author should be in bold**. Abstracts should be submitted to apacon2026@bhu.ac.in before **10th August, 2026**.

Delegates may indicate their preferred technical session and mode of presentation (oral or poster). The author will solely be responsible for disputes, if any. For poster presentations, the poster size should be 3 ft (width) × 4 ft (height).

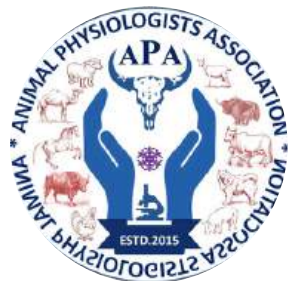
